

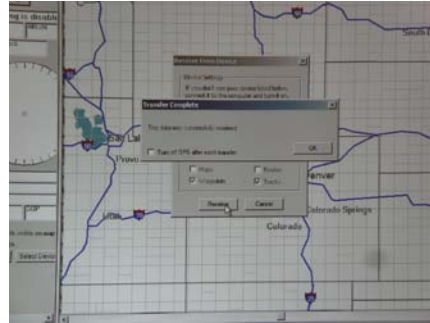
7th Annual OHV Management Workshop: "PUTTING THE GRASS ROOTS BACK INTO THE GAS ROUTES"
